
IN THE YEAR 2021



LEADING-EDGE INSTRUCTION

Program has continued to develop innovative and effective approaches to provide high quality education to our students, utilizing the latest technologies available. As our ability to gather together evolved during the year, the **Business & Entrepreneurship Campus** Program was able to offer a concurrent worldwide classroom. This Concurrent model provides live instructor-led training simultaneously to students sitting in the classroom along with those attending online. This configuration provides an alternative to learners who prefer to receive instruction that includes live instruction, real-time interaction with instructors and classmates (inperson and remotely), and in-class exercises applying principles being taught.

BRO-N-LAWS BAR-B-QUE RESTAURANT

In addition to their classroom innovations, our graduates continue to have success in the marketplace and make a positive different in their communities. The first example of this is Ken Johnson, who is the owner and chief operating officer of Bro-N-Laws Bar-b-que restaurant on Chicago's West side. Ken is an ex-offender and a recovering drug addict and had owned his restaurant for almost 10 years before enrolling in Joseph Business School (JBS). Ken's restaurant is in an economically challenged neighborhood that does not have much food or business activity. During his time in business, Ken was unsatisfied with the state of his business as he struggled to grow it to the levels he desired. After attending JBS and implementing the business and faith concepts that he learned at school, Ken is excited to share that even during Covid challenges, his business has doubled to being just over the \$1 million sales goal he established in school. As a result, he has been able to make structural improvements to his building and provide jobs to 11 employees. Ken shared that he feels very blessed that he has turned his "hustle" into a well-structured operational business.

Sweet Potato Patch

JBS graduate Stacey Minor the CEO of Sweet Potato Patch, which is headquartered in Chicago, IL, continues to thrive with her business that provides easier access to healthy foods to people who live in urban food deserts.

The way they accomplish this is through buying fresh produce directly from disadvantaged and underserved farmers across the country. They then package the produce and, using GPS tracked delivery technology, deliver it to the doorsteps of their customers. Additionally, using her background in plant biotechnology, Stacy has developed meal kits that are scientifically designed to help address chronic health challenges faced by many residents in these areas. Recently, Stacey has contracted with large managed care organizations to expand her business's area of service beyond Chicagoland to other Illinois communities, such as Rockford, Joliet, and East St. Louis.


- Provide capital for new business start-ups, expansions, and ideas.
